If, after completing the questionnaire and sending it, you don't hear from me within 3 or 4 days please contact me via email or phone...I will ALWAYS acknowledge receipt of a questionnaire no matter what, I have been through the agony of writing to a breeder and never hearing back and I will not do that to anyone! If I am away, at a dog show or for any other reason, for more than 2 days, I usually remember to put an automatic reply on my email so you would get a note telling you when I'll be back. If you are interested in breeding this dog, what are your reasons for breeding?

If your plans are to one day breed your puppy, are you willing to have the puppy's eyes CERF certified and hips x-rayed after the puppy is 24 months of age and before they are bred?

Are you aware of some of the health problem which can appear in some Aussies today such as medication sensitivities?

Are you aware that Australian Shepherds are medium sized and *very* active dogs that shed (sometimes quite profusely)?

Are you willing to deal with these attributes that are so much a part of an Aussie?

If you had to choose between two puppies, one with perfect conformation, but low-moderate drive, and one with so-so conformation (not as well marked as expected in a show/breeding puppy) and high drive, which one would you choose and why?
